## Practical information

**Price of the conference** The price is €150 for the adult programme and €90 for the teenagers. This includes all food and beverages, travelling to the outside programmes, the lectures and workshops. Please, send your registration before **29 June 2016**. You can apply after this date, but then we need to ask a small extra fee. For applications till the end of July the price is €160, till the end of August €170, and in September €200. For the teenagers the price remains the same.

**Travelling** If you come by plane, choose Budapest Liszt Ferenc Airport (that's the only civilian airport in Budapest). When booking your flight take note that it will take at least 2 hours to get to Veszprém. From the airport you should travel to Déli Pályaudvar (South Station). You can do this in the following ways:

1. Take the bus (nr. 200E – that's the only bus from there) till its end station (Kőbánya/Kispest). You can buy tickets for €1 at the machine, you need one for the bus and one for the underground. You do not need to validate a new one when you change metro lines. At Kőbánya/Kispest take the underground line M3 (no problems here, it is also an end station). Get off at Deák Ferenc tér and change to underground M2 to Déli Pályaudvar (end station).
2. Take any number of taxis, minibuses ([www.minibud.hu](http://www.minibud.hu) – you can book either at the airport or online) from the airport directly to Déli Pályaudvar. This will cost around €15-25, but of course you are much cheaper off when you share. The Főtaxi and the Minibud are reliable companies.

When you are at Déli Pályaudvar you need to take the train to Veszprém. The timetable is available in English on [www.mavcsoport.hu/en](http://www.mavcsoport.hu/en). You can buy your ticket (€8) at the counter or the ticket machine. It takes 1.5 hours comfortable travelling to reach Veszprém. We will need your arrival time in order to be able to pick you up at the train station.

Contact us if you travel by car or international train, we'll let you know the best options

**Accommodation** You can choose from the options we summarised for you (see other link on website), and then book the hotel directly. Do this as soon as you arrange your travelling. We have other options but these are the most practical ones for the venue of the conference. It is also a good selection in every price range. In the file all the prices are added in Hungarian forint. The exchange rate can change of course, but count with this rate, then you can't really go wrong: €1 is 300 HUF. So if a hotel room is 10000 HUF per night that means about €33.

We did not add the hotel prices in euros, because usually you are better off if you pay with HUF or with your bank card; the hotels generally use an exchange rate which is better for them than you.

**Hungarian forint** As described above the exchange rate moves around €1 is 300 HUF. Do not change money at the airport – you get the worst rate, people sometimes lose as much as 25-30%. There is an ATM machine at the airport, you can draw some cash there. Generally I find that the best option is to use your cash card everywhere. (Check the international costs of your bank.)
